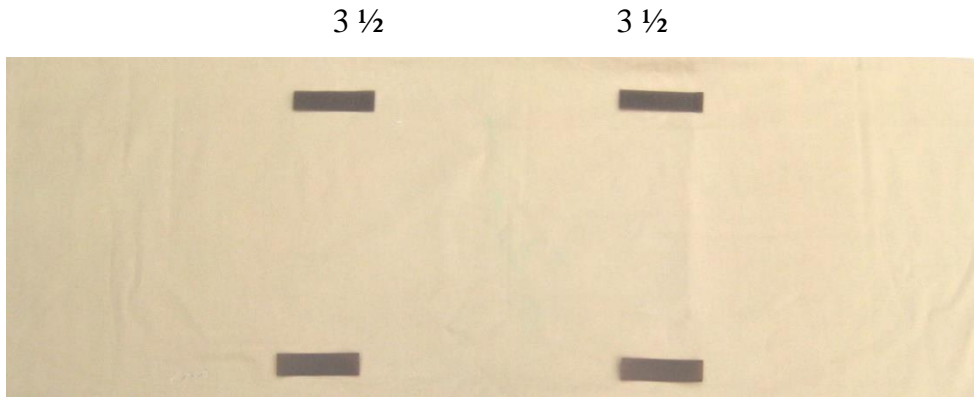


MMQG Walker Bag Instructions (revised 11/17)

1. Cut 2 pieces of coordinating fabric 14 X 40 inches.
Cut 2 sets of velcro 3 inches long.
2. With RST, sew all 4 sides together with a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam. Leave a 6 inch opening to turn right side out. Clip the corners diagonally. Push corners out.
3. Pull fabric right side out thru the 6 inch opening. Press fabric flat.
4. Mark the center point of each long side with a pin.
5. Measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches from the center point of each long side. Place the short side of the velcro at this $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch mark and $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches in from the edge. Attach all 4 velcro pieces using these measurements.



6. To make the pockets, fold up each end 6 inches.
NOTE: The velcro stitches will show on the top. This is not important.
Spacing to accommodate the walker bar is important
7. Sew around the entire perimeter of the bag. Be sure the opening used to turn the bag is covered by this stitch. Back stitch at the top of the pockets for added stability.
8. Sew a middle seam down the center of each pocket to form 2 pockets on each side. Back stitch at the top of pocket for stability. Add a MMQG tag inside walker bag.
